All applicants must meet **ONE** of the entrance requirements listed below:

As of August 5, 2024, all degrees and/or courses must be completed before you are eligible to apply. CVIU does not accept any degrees or courses that are "In Progress."

Prerequisite 1:

- **1.** High school diploma, GED, or its equivalent.
- **2.** A bachelor's degree.
- **3.** Submission of ACT and/or SAT score.
- **4.** In addition to the degree, all applicants must have taken the following prerequisite courses and passed the course with a C average:
 - a. One basic science course (i.e., biology, microbiology, chemistry, physics, etc.)
 - b. Algebra, Statistics, or a higher mathematics course
 - c. English, Speech, or Writing Composition
 - d. Anatomy & Physiology I & II or an A&P course that covers the entire body
 - e. Medical Terminology

Prerequisite 2:

- **1.** High school diploma, GED, or its equivalent.
- 2. An associate degree.
- **3.** Minimum ACT score of 20 or SAT score of 1030-1050.
- **4.** In addition to the degree, all applicants must have taken the following prerequisite courses and passed the course with a C average:
 - a. One basic science course (i.e., biology, microbiology, chemistry, physics, etc.)
 - b. Algebra, Statistics, or a higher mathematics course
 - c. English, Speech, or Writing Composition
 - d. Anatomy & Physiology I & II or an A&P course that covers the entire body
 - e. Medical Terminology

Prerequisite 3:

- **1.** High school diploma, GED, or its equivalent.
- Minimum 45 college credits with an overall GPA of a 3.0, in a healthcare or science field, such as pre-nursing, pre-med, pre-radiological sciences, physical therapy, biology, exercise science, health sciences, etc.
- 3. Minimum ACT score of 20 or SAT score of 1030/1050.
- **4.** In addition to the degree, all applicants must have taken the following prerequisite courses and passed the course with a C average:
 - a. One basic science course (i.e., biology, microbiology, chemistry, physics, etc.)
 - b. Algebra, Statistics, or a higher mathematics course

- c. English, Speech, or Writing Composition
- d. Anatomy & Physiology I & II or an A&P course that covers the entire body
- e. Medical Terminology

**Medical Terminology and Anatomy & Physiology Courses: If an applicant is accepted into a program at CVIU by meeting the Composite Entrance Score requirements, has a degree, and at least a 3.0 GPA, they may take Medical Terminology and/or Anatomy and Physiology with CVIU online.

Medical Terminology and Anatomy and Physiology courses are only offered if accepted into the program and cannot be transferred to other colleges.

The Medical Terminology course and the Anatomy and Terminology course are not institutionally or programmatically accredited as part of your concerned program of enrollment.

Both A&P and Medical Terminology must be completed prior to enrollment
